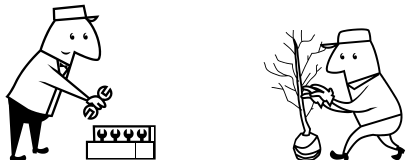

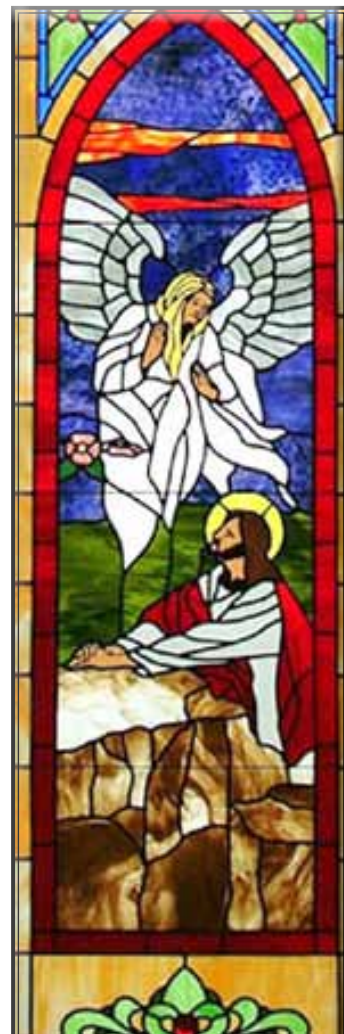

SESSION HIGHLIGHTS

Facilities and Property: PW had work day and discovered many items in the pantry that do not belong at the church. Check the items and take them home. Some paint touch ups will be done in the near future.

Health Ministries: is excited about the Connect program and suggests there be a time to walk.

Member Care: Session will host a Job Fair after worship February 6. Each mission team will be responsible for a display and snacks.

Reaching Out: Team plans to sponsor a chili cook off on April 9. They are working on many ideas. One of the top projects they are trying to get up and working is the establishment of a computer center for use by members of the congregation and the community (especially intermediate school students who do not have computers at home but need one to do their homework).

Worship: Epiphany will be observed January 9. Star gifts will be distributed and there will be cake for fellowship time. GIFT services will not be held on Sunday evenings due to low attendance. Prayer for Healing services will be done formally on January 30 and May 29 but will be done informally every Sunday if there is need and interest. Plans are to begin learning and using more songs from the MCB songbook. Ordination and installation of elders will be January 9. All elders will be invited forward for the laying on of hands

during the prayer but the welcome and greeting of new elders will be done in the fellowship hall following worship.

Pastor Lorraine will convene a D. Ministries team consulting group consisting of 4 men and 4 women she will ask to help on her project that is due in May.

Connect program will be Saturdays at 2 p.m. and will begin January 15. It is an intergenerational program with various activities.

Session agreed to allow the following fund raisers: Souper Bowl of Caring offering on February 6, PW soup and chili lunch following worship on February 20, and Youth Mexican fundraiser lunch following worship on February 27.

Session set an elder retreat to be held at the Willard Library (if the facility is available) on March 12 from 9 a.m.-1 p.m. Pastor is attempting to find a time to have Bible Study possibly on Wednesday night. Debbie Newman will also try to set up a computer based Bible Study.

Kevin Peterson will teach the confirmation class. He and Pastor Lorraine want to use "Professing Our Faith" based on the Presbyterian "We Believe" literature. The literature will be purchased and paid for by the Sunday school checking account. The literature has more sessions than will be needed for confirmation. The extras can be used for Sunday school class or youth group.
